Note: The OverDrive app is available for Android, Chromebook, iOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch). Kindle Fire tablets, NOOK tablets and Windows 8 and up. If you have an Android, iOS, or Window 10 device, you can also try Libby, OverDrive's new one-tap reading app.


